



Job Description – Information Systems Coordinator*

Broetje Orchards is seeking an experienced Information Systems Coordinator to help manage the company's business software systems. Coordinator must be willing to learn, understand and utilize multiple software systems across multiple departments. Position requires hands-on experience managing, trouble-shooting, and launching multiple business software/hardware systems and projects. The ideal candidate will have experience with Famous software or other produce-related software. The candidate should be an independent, motivated self-starter who values working in a "team" setting. Communication and teamwork are key skill traits. Formal education, training and working experience in the area of Information Management Systems, or other related field is required. Bilingual communication skills are a plus. This is a year-round position located near the Tri-Cities. Some travel is required to service additional growing areas near Benton City and Wallula. This position reports to the Broetje Orchards Business Manager.

Broetje Orchards is one of the largest family-owned and operated tree fruit companies – growing, packing, shipping, and marketing over 6 million boxes of apples a year. - Present a continuing education plan annually to remain current on emerging technologies and new practices being developed
- Configure and manage a diverse network system
